An Act to grant and apply an additional sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and eight for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 3rd June, 1908.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Additional Appropriation short title. (Works and Buildings) Act 1907-8.
- 2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and Fund, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted application of to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and eight the sum of One hundred and sixty-one thousand two hundred and eighty-two pounds.
- 3. The said sum granted by this Act is appropriated and shall Appropriation be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of supply. of the Act No. 2 of 1907 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule.
