"First appointments will, as a rule, be rande to the rank of Second Licuteurat Chut to reak of Coptain in the case of the Australian Army Medical Corps and to the rank of Licuteurat in the case of the Australian Littelligence Corps and Australian Army Veleriumry Corps),"

is concelled, and the following substituted therefor:-

"67. First appointments will, on a rule, be made to the rank of Sentina Licettennat (but to rank of Captain in the case of the Australian Army Medical Corps, and of the Army Voterinary Corps (Citizen Forces), and to the rank of Licettennat in the case of the Australian Sintelligence Corps)."
