PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1912.

RECOULATIONS FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH-REQULATIONS 2, 3, AND 4-AMENDMENTS.

T. THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the odvice of the Federal Executive Council, interthy cartify that, on account of urgency, the following Regulations under the Defence Act 1903-1912 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulations to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations.

AMENDMENTS.

The Military Board.

Regulation 2 .- The paragraph which reads as follows:-

"The Military Board will refer all matters in connexion with the appointments of Commandants and Olicors of the Dietrick Hoodquaters Staffs, and the appointments of Officers to command for regiments and corps to the Inspector-General for his edvice and recommendation."

"The Military Board will consider and make recommendations with regard to all promotions in the Military Forces to ranks above the rank of Major as well as the appointment of officers to be Commandants and to command regiments and corps."

The Inspector-General, President.

The Adjutant-General, and the Senior District Commandant doing duty with treops; Members.

The Chief of Ordnance will attend the meetings of the Board to advise on all promotions of Artillery and Engineer Officers. C.1869 .- Price 3n.

The Prometion Board will consider and make recommendations with regard to all prometions in the Military Forces of the Commonwealth to ranks above the rank of Major, as well as the appointments of officers to be Commandants, and to command regiments and corns.

The recommendations of the Frometion Board will be forwarded to the Scoretary of the Dapartment of Defence for submission to the Ministor."
