PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1914-1915.

WAR PRECAUTIONS REGULATION NG. 52 (2) (A)-AMENDMENT.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, heroby certify that, on account of argency, the following Regulation under the War Precautions Act 1914-1915 should came into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith os a Provisional Regulation.

WAR PRECAUTIONS REGULATION No. 52 (2) (A).

Amendment.

The War Precautians Regulatians 1915 (Statutory Rules 1915, No. 77), are amended by ropealing sub-paragraph (2) (ii) of paragraph 52, and by inserting the following in its place:

"(2) (a) The Minister or any competent naval or military authority may, by order, require any corporation or person of any class or description to furnish him, either verbally or in writing, with such infarmatian, and to produce to him such documents, hooks and papers, relative to any matter affecting the public safety ar the defence of the Contmonwealth, as may be specified in the order, and the Minister or the competent uaval or military authority may take copies of or extracts from such documents, books and papers, and may impound and retain such documents, hooks and papers, for such time as he thinks necessary."
