## PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1914-1916.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Cammonwealth of Australia. acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the following Regulations under the iVar Precartions Act 1914-1916 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulations to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations.

AMENDMENT OF WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES ADJUSTMENT) RESULATIONS 1916.

(Statutory Rutes 1916, No. 40, as amended by Statutory Rules 1916, Nos. 46, 53, 82, and 96.)

- 1 The heading to Ragulation 13 of the War Precautions (Prices Amendment of Adjustment) Regulations is amended by omitting thersfrom the wards beading to "on Sugar."
- 2. Regulation t3 of the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regu Amendment of Regulations is amanded—
  - (a) by amitting fram sub-Regulation (1) thereof the words "refined engar" and by inserting the ward "goods" in their stead; and
  - (b) by inserting in sub-Regulation (3) thereof, after the word "Regulation," tha words "fixing the meximum freight which may be charged on the carriage of refined sugar."
- 3 Regulation 14 of the Wnr Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regu. Amendment of latinus is amended by omitting therefrom the wards "refined sugar" Revolution 14. and inserting the ward "goods" in their stead.
- 4 After Regulation t4 of the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations, the foliawing Regulation is inserted:-

"t5 From and after the date of the communement of this Regu. Proteined those provailing at the date of the mode in the chorges for freight, beyand these provailing at the date of the modeing of this Regulation, on the carriage of gende from any port in Austrolia to any ather port in Australia, unless the written consent of the Minister has firet
