## PROVISIONAL REGULATION UNDER THE WAR

Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgancy, the following Regulation under the War Precautions det 1914 1916 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a Provinganal Regulation.

Amendment of War Precautions (Prices Adjustment)
Regulations 1916.

(Statutory Rules 1916, No. 40, as amonded by Statutory Rules 1916, Nos. 46, 53, 82, 96, and 118.)

After Regulation 11 of the War Procautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations the following Regulation is inserted:-

"11a (1) The Minister may, if its think fit, appoint a person to Appetument of conduct any inquiry in the Northern Territory which is considered protected by the Minister to be necessary for the purposes of these Regula Sentern Territory.

(2) For the purpose of any such inquiry the person so appointed shall have end may exercise all the powers and functions conferred on the Board by the preceding Regulations."
