## PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1914-1916.

I, SIR ARTHUR STANLEY, Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia, acting as the Deputy of the Governor-General in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the following Regulations under the *War Precautions Act 1914-1916* should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulations to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations.

### AMENDMENT OF WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES ADJUSTMENT) REGULATIONS 1916.

(Statutory Rules 1916, No. 40, as amended by Statutory Rules 1916, Nos. 46, 53, 82, 96, 118 and 119.)

1. Regulation 2 of the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations is amended by adding at the end thereof the following definition:—  
“ *the Minister* ” means the Minister of State for Defence.” Amendment of Regulation 2.
2. Regulation 8 of the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations is amended by omitting therefrom the words “ the Governor-General ” (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words “ the Minister.” Amendment of Regulation 8.
3. Regulation 9 of the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations is amended by omitting therefrom the words “ the Governor-General ” (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words “ the Minister.” Amendment of Regulation 9.
4. Regulation 13 of the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations is amended by omitting therefrom the words “ the Governor-General ” (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words “ the Minister.” Amendment of Regulation 13.
