REGULATIONS UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and aver the Cammonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the War Precautions Act 1914-1916, to come into appretion farthwith.

WAR PRECAUTIONS (ALIENS REGISTRATION) REGULATIONS 1916.

1. These Ragulatians may be cited as the War Precautions (Aliena about 1914, Registration) Regulations 1916.

These Regulations shall came into farce on the first day of October Conserve One thousand nine hundred and sixteen.

3. In these Regulations, unless the contrary latention appears-

Delmiticas.

"Alien" means any alien friend or alien enomy aver the age of fifteen years and includes the wife of an alien;
"Aliens Registration Officer" means any aliens registration

officer appointed far the purposes of these Regulations;

"Minister" means the Minister of State for Defence.

"Officer" means a member of the police force, or an officer of Customs, or a competent navel or military authority under the War Precautions Regulations 1915, or any person unthorized by a competent navel or military authority to exercise the powers canforred on officers by these Regulatins.

5. (1) Not later then the thirty-first day of October. One thousand currentes on nine hundred and sixteen, avery alien resident in the Commonwealth siles to shall, unless ha is exempted by or under these Regulations, register himself as an alien in accordance with those Regulations, and overy alien who refuses or falls to do so within the time allowed shall be cuilty of an offence.

- (2) Every alien entering the Commenwealth after the thirty-first day of October. One thousand nine hundred and sixteen, shall, within saven days after so entering the Commenwealth, unless he is exempted hy or under these Regulations, register himself as an alien in accordance with these Regulations, and every alien who refuses or fails to do so within the time allawed shall he guilty of an offence.
- (3) Every child of an allen resident in the Commonwealth, not being a child who is by birth a natural born British subject, shall within one month after he attains the age of fifteen years register himself, or he registered by his parent or by the person standing to him in loco parentis, as an alien in accordance with these Regulations, nuless he is exempted by or under these Regulations, and every child who refuses or fails to register himself, and every pareat of any such child or person standing in loco purents to any such child who reluces or fails to register the child within the time allowed, shall be guilty of an offence:

8. Upan the registration of an alien in accordance with these Regula- resue of tiens, a certificate of registration in accordance with Ferm B in the exclusion Schedule to these Regulations shall be issued to him.

9. (1) Every alien, whether registered in accordance with these ophysican as Regulations or not, whe changes his place of aboda, shall within soven siles to sailly days after so changing his place of abode natify that fact to the Alicus abod. Registration Officer nearest to his new place of ahede, and every alien who rafuses ar fails to do so shall be guilty of un offence,

(2) The notification shall be given by the alien properly completing s natice (in duplicate) in accordance with Form C in the Schedule to these Regulations, and stiending in person with such notice before that Aliens Registration Officer.

(3) This paragraph does not apply to nn alien who travels in the Commonwealth, or who travois in a vessel between Commonwealth ports as a momber of the crow or as a passenger without changing his usual change of residence.

10. (1) It shall be the duty of the keeper of avery hetel, inn, board- Register of inghouse, and lodginghouse in Australia, to oscertain and enter in a register kept for the purpose the somes and nationalities of all cliens bettereen. staving at the hotel, inn. boardinghouse, or ledginghouse, together with the dates of their arrival and departure, their destinations on departure, and such other particulars as may be required by the Minister by netice published in the Cazette, and if the keeper of an hotel, inn, beardinghouse, or ledginghouse, fails to do so, or if he makes any entry in any such register which he knows, or could by the exercise of reseasable difference have secertained to be false, he shall be guilty of an effence.

(2) The keeper of every hotel, inn, boardinghouse, or ledginghouse shall also, if directions for the purpose are issued by an Aliens Registration Officer, make to that Officer such returns as to the particulors aforesaid, at such times or intervals, and in such form, as may be succified in such directions, and if he falls to do so or makes any false return,

ha simil be quilty of an offence.

(3) It shall be the duty of every parsen who stays at an izotel, inn. boardinghouse, or lodginghouse, to furnish to the keeper thereof, and sign, a statement containing such information as such keeper may require far the purpose of compiling such register as aforessid, and if any person fails to do so, or gives any faise infarmation, he shall be guilty of an offenea.

(4) Every register kent under this paragraph shall at all reasonable hours he open to inspection by any Officer or Alions Registration Officer. er any other person authorized by an Aliens Registration Officer.

(5) Far the purposes of this paragraph the appression "keeper of a ladginghouse" shall include any person who for roward receives ony other person to lodge with him or in his bouse; and where any hotol. ing, poardinghause, or lodginghouse is under the management of a manager, the expression "keeper" shall in relation thereto lackude the mausger.
