## REGULATIONS UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1914.1976.

SIR ARTHUR STANLEY, Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, acting as the Deputy of the Governor-General, in accordance with the pravisions of the Constitution, setting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the War Precontinue Act 1914-1916 to come into operation forthwith.

AMENDMENT OF WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES) RECULATIONS 1916.

## (Statutory Rules 1916, No. 155.)

- 1. Regulation 4 of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations is "Baard" (wherever it occurs) and inserting in its stead the word "Minister."
- 2. Regulation 6 of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations is amended by omiting therefrom Sub-regulation (2).
- 3. Regulation 11 of the War Precantions (Prices) Regulations is amonded.

  - (a) by inserting in Sub-regulation (I) thereof—
    (i) after the word "Board" (first occurring) the words "and each Cammissioner";

    - (ii) after the word "Board" (second occurring) the wards "or the Commissioner"; and (iii) after the word "Beard" (last occurring) the words "or the Commissioner as the case may be";
  - (b) by inserting after the word "Board" in Sub-regulation (2. thereof the words "or a Cammissianer"; and
    - (c) by emitting, from Sub-regulation (I) thereaf, the words " of the Board".
- Regulation 12 of the War Proceedings (Prices) Regulations is anaded by inserting after the word "Baard" (wherever occurring) the words "or a Commissioner".
- 5. Regulatian 13 of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations is amended by inserting after the word "Board" the words " ar a Commissioner".
- 6. Regulation 14 of the War Presentions (Prices) Regulations is amended by inserting after the ward "Board" the wards "or a Commissioner".
