## REGULATIONS UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1014-1016.

WAR PREGAUTIONS REGULATIONS 1915—REQULATION 590—AMENDMENT.

I THE GOVERNOR GENERAL, in and over the Commenwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the War Precautions Act 1914-1916, to come into operation forthwith.

THE WAR PRECAUTIONS REGULATIONS 1915.

Amendment.

Regulation 50n which reads-

59s. Every document purporting to be an order or other instru-tentre of most issued by a competent Naval or Military authority and to competent be signed by such an authority shall be received in evidence and makes or be deemed to be such an order or instrument without further proof sulleary unless the contrary is shown,

is cancelled, and the following substituted therefor:-

50n. Every document purporting to be an order or other instru-Evidence or ment issued by a competent Naval or Military authority or holder effects action and to be signed by such an authority, holder of an office, deficer or person, shall be received in cridence and be deemed to be such an order or instrument without further proof unless the contrary is shown.
