REGULATION UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1014-1016.

AMENDMENT OF THE WAN PRECAUTIONS (SUPPLEMENTARY) REOULATIONS 1910.

(Statutory Rules 1016, No. 07, as amended by Statutory Rules 1016, Nos. 112, 122, 128, 120, 136, 167, 218, 210, 260, 262, 254, 255, 263, 271, 273, 273, 280, 203, and 268.)

After Regulation 22, the following Regulation is inserted :-

"23. No person shall, except in necordance with the permission production at in writing of the Prime Minister, or in accordance with permission and of work or notified by the Prime Minister in the Gazette, sell or offer for the accordance sale, or buy or offer to buy, either an his own behalf or on behalf of any other person, any wool or dry sheep-this."
