WAR PRECAUTIONS (PASSPORTS) REGULATIONS 1916—REGULATION 5-

"(ia) any British subject a member of the erew of an overseave arriving in the Commonwealth who leaves the Commonwealth in continuation of the same voyage in the same vessel."
