REGULATION UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1914-1918.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth , of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the War Precuntions Act 1914-1918, to come into operation forthwith.

Amendment of the War Precautions Act as Amended to this DATE.

After regulation 640 of the War Precautions Regulations, the following regulation is inserted:

"64E. Any person who has been deported from the Common-prohibited wealth in pursuance of the provisions of the Aliens Restriction Order 1915 or of the Unlawful Associations Act 1916-1917 is prohibited from entering the Commonwealth and any such person who enters or attempts to enter the Commonwealth in contravention of this regulation shall be deemed to be and liable to be dealt with as a prohibited immigrant within the meaning of the Immigration Act 1901-1912."
