REGULATIONS UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1914-1918.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *War Precautions Act 1914-1918*, to come into operation forthwith.

AMENDMENT OF WAR PRECAUTIONS (SUPPLEMENTARY) REGULATIONS AS AMENDED TO THIS DATE.

1. Regulation 2 of the War Precautions (Supplementary) Regulations is amended—

- (a) by inserting in sub-regulation (1.), after the word "word" (fourth and last occurring), the words "or mark";
- (b) by inserting in sub-regulations (2.), (3.) and (4.), after the word "word" (wherever occurring), the words "or mark"; and
- (c) by inserting in paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (4), after the word "words", the words "or marks".

2. Regulation 2A of the War Precautions (Supplementary) Regulations is amended by inserting, after the word "word" (fourth and last occurring), the words "or mark".
