REGULATION UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1914-1918.

THE GOVERNOR-OENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the War Precautions Act 1914-1918, to come into operation forthwith.

Amendment of the War Precautions (Supplementary) Regulations as Amended to this Date.

Regulation 56 of the War Precautions (Supplementary) Regulations

- (a) by inserting in stb-regulation (1) thereof, after the words "enemy subject", the words "or a naturalized subject of enemy origin";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) of sub-regulation (2) thereof the word "the" (second occurring) and inserting in its stead the words "any such"; and
- (c) by omitting from sub-regulation (3) thereof the word "an" and inserting in its stead the words "any such".
