REGULATIONS UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT 1901-1923.

AMENDMENT OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH REGULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1913, No. 348, as amended to this date.)

Regulation 243 is amended-

- (a) by inserting after the words "Inter-State Parcels" the words " and on parcels addressed to Lord Howe Island, to the Territories of Norfolk Island and Papna and to the Mandated Territory of New Gainen"; and
- (b) by inserting after the word "Inter-State" in the column headed "Destination" of the table of rates the words "Lord Howe Island, the Territories of Norfolk Island or Papna, and the Manidated Territory of New Guinea."
