## REGULATIONS UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT 1901-1923.

**I** THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the undermentioned amended Regulation under the *Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1923*, to come into operation forthwith.

### AMENDMENT OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH REGULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1913, No. 348, as amended to this date.)

Regulation 243 is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the words "Inter-State Parcels" the words "and on parcels addressed to Lord Howe Island, to the Territories of Norfolk Island and Papua and to the Mandated Territory of New Guinea"; and
- (b) by inserting after the word "Inter-State" in the column headed "Destination" of the table of rates the words "Lord Howe Island, the Territories of Norfolk Island or Papua, and the Mandated Territory of New Guinea."
