## REGULATIONS UNDER THE EXCISE ACT 1901-1923.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the Excise Act 1901-1923, to come into operation forthwith.

AMENDMENT OF EXCISE REGULATIONS 1913.

(Statutory Rules 1913, No. 345, as amended to this date.)

- 1. Regulation 115A of the Excise Regulations 1913 is amended by adding after the words "Australian rectified spirit" the words "and Australian absolute alcohol."
- 2. Regulation 115s of the Excise Regulations 1913 is amended by deleting the word "spirit" (wherever occurring), and inserting the words "rectified spirit" in lieu thereof.
- 3. Regulation 1151 of the Excise Regulations 1913 is amended—(a) by deleting the word "spirit" (wherever occurring), and inserting the words "rectified spirit" in lieu thereof; and (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—
  - "(2) The total quantity of absolute alcohol which may be delivered under these Regulations for use in any public hospital shall not exceed 12 gallons per annum."
