REGULATIONS UNDER THE NAVAL DEFENCE ACT 1910-1918.

AMENDMENT OF FLEET RESERVE REQULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1923, No. 52, as amended to present date.)

- 1. Regulation 31 is annualed as from 1st July, 1924, by omitting from the feurth and fifth lines of sub-regulation (1) the words "Deferred Pay being paid with Active Pay" and inserting in their stead the words "except Deferred Pay which shall not be credited".
- 2. Regulation 46 is amended as from 1st July, 1924, by emitting from the fifth line of sub-regulation (1) the words "Deferred Pay being paid with Active Pay" and inserting in their stead the words "including Deforred Pay".
