REGULATION UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT 1901-1923.

AMENDMENT OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH REGULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1913, No. 348, as amended to this date.)

Regulation 71d is amended by inserting in sub-regulation (2) (c) after the word "sureties" the words "or alternatively with an approved guarantee company as surety".
