## REGULATION UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT 1901-1923.

AMENDMENT OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH REGULATIONS. (Statutory Rules 1913, No. 348, as amended to this date.)

Regulation 119 is amended by-

- (a) inscring in sub-Regulation (2) after the words "Ohliterated complete sets of" the words "current and obsolete",
- (b) by omitting from sub-Regulation (2) the words "Ten shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "One peund".
