REGULATION UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT 1901-1923.

AMENDMENT OF THE POSTAL REGULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1927, No. 144, as amended to this date.)

The Postal Regulations are amended by the addition of the following regulation:—

258. Stamp duty under the law of any State shall not be payable on any receipt given in connexion with any transaction under these Regulations. Stamp duty on receipts.
