BILLS OF EXCHANGE.

No. 61 of 1932.

An Act to amend the *Bills of Exchange Act*  
1909-1912.

[Assented to 5th December, 1932.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,  
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of  
Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Bills of Exchange Act* 1932.

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Bills of Exchange Act 1909-1912\** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the *Bills of Exchange Act 1909-1932*.

2. After section eighty-eight of the Principal Act the following section is inserted in Division 2 of Part III. :—

Cheques drawn  
by a bank  
on itself.

“88A. For the purposes of this division ‘cheque’ includes a banker’s draft payable on demand drawn by or on behalf of a bank upon itself, whether payable at the head office or at some other office of the Bank.”.
