## REGULATIONS UNDER THE COMMONWEALTH EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ACT 1930.\*

### AMENDMENTS TO EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 14 of the Employees' Compensation Regulations is amended by adding at the end thereof the words— Commonwealth Authorities.

“Rifle Clubs, State Rifle Associations and District Rifle Club Unions formed or established in accordance with the Australian Rifle Club Regulations.”.

2. After regulation fourteen of the Employees' Compensation Regulations, the following regulation is inserted:—

“14A. Liability under the Act to pay compensation in respect of personal injury by accident arising out of and in the course of the employment on a rifle range of an employee of a Rifle Club, State Rifle Association or District Rifle Club Union, who is employed in the actual conduct of a rifle practice or competition, shall be borne by the Commonwealth.” Special liability of Commonwealth.
