MEAT EXPORT CONTROL (EXPENSES) REGULATIONS.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Meat Export Control Citation. (Expenses) Regulations.
- 2.—(1.) Where any member attends a meeting of the Board or Expenses of the Committee, as the case may be, he shall be reimbursed the members. expenses incurred by him in connexion with his attendance at that meeting.
- (2.) In this regulation "member" means a member of the Board or of the Executive Committee of the Board or the Beef Committee of the Board, and includes the Chairman of the Board and any deputy of a member of the Board.
