Amendment of Royal Military College Regulations.

- 1. Regulation 2 of the Royal Military College Regulations is Subdivision. ${\it amended}$ —

 (b) by omitting the words "a member of the Defence Force" amended in paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (1) -

 - and inserting in their stead the words "an applicant under the proviso to regulation 5".

- 12. Regulation 28 of the Royal Military College Regulations is tength of amended in sub-regulation (1) by omitting the word "admitted", course. where it twice occurs, and inserting in its stead the word "selected"

13. Appendix IV. of the Royal Military College Regulations is Educational amended in the heading by omitting the words "under the age of qualifications required of nineteen years" and inserting in their stead the words "for normal confidence for normal entry.

14. Appendix V. of the Royal Military College Regulations is Examination of Commonwealth amended-

(a) in the heading by omitting the words "over the age of admission nineteen years" and inserting in their stead the words under the proviso to regulation 5. tion 5"; and

(b) under the sub-heading "(i) General", by omitting in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph the words "approved by the Director-General of Medical Services"; and

(c) under the sub-heading "(v) Forms used in the Examination", by omitting in the sub-headings of A.A.F.'s K.2, K.3, and K.7 the words "over the age of nincteen years" and inserting in their stead the words "for admission

as students under the proviso to regulation 5"; and (d) by omitting the letters and figure "A.A.F. K.4(a)", wherever occurring, and inserting in their stead the letters and figure "A.A.F. K.4".

15. Appendix VI. of the Royal Military College Regulations is Instructions ended—

(a) by omitting paragraph 8. and inserting in its stead the examination. amended-

following paragraph:

"8. The Deputy Director of Medical Services shall-

(a) inform the District Base Commandant of the result of the medical examination; and

(b) forward the proceedings of the Medical Board, in duplicate, with A.A.F. D1 and A.A.F. D4 attached, to the Director-General of Medical Services for review and transmission to the Commandant, Royal Military College."; and

(b) in paragraph 9, by omitting the words "over the age of nineteen years" and inserting in their stead the words "for admission as students under the proviso to regulation δ ".
