AMENDMENT OF ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE REGULATIONS.†

Appendix V. of the Royal Military College Regulations is amended under the sub-heading “(vi) Syllabus of Examination” by—

- Examination of Commonwealth candidates for admission as students under the proviso to regulation 5.
- (a) omitting, in the title of the text-book for Subject 8, Physics, the words “Elements of Physics” and inserting in their stead the words “Intermediate Physics”; and
 - (b) omitting, in the title of the text-book for Subject 11, Geometrical Drawing, the words “Practical Solid Geometry—*Atkinson* (Spon Ltd.)” and inserting in their stead the words “Geometrical Drawing and Design—*Spanton* (Macmillan & Co. Ltd.)”; and
 - (c) omitting, in the detail of Subject 11, Geometrical Drawing, the words “grouped under cases (i), (ii) and (iii) of the text-book, Chapters I. and II.” and inserting in their stead the words “Chapters XII. and XIII.”.
