An Act to amend the Representation Act 1905.

[Assented to 30th June, 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:---

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Representation Act 1938.

(2.) The Representation Act 1905* is in this Act referred to as and citation. the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Representation Act 1905-1938.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement receives the Royal Assent.

3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Appointment of Enumeration sub-section (2.).

4. Section four of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraph (b) of sub-section (1.); and

(b) by omitting sub-sections (2.) and (3.).

5. Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Power to make from sub-section (3.) the words and letters "Schedules A and B, or either of them" and inserting in their stead the word and letter "Schedule B".

6. The Principal Act is amended by omitting Schedule A.
