REGULATIONS UNDER THE COMMONWEALTH CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION ACT 1904-1934.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 10 of the Conciliation and Arbitration Regulations is amended by inserting in sub-regulation (1), after the word "days", the words "or, in the case of an application for registration by an association the previous registration of which has been cancelled, seven days".^{Objections to registration.}

2. Form 3 in the Schedule to the Conciliation and Arbitration Regulations is amended by omitting the word "thirty".^{Form 3.}
