## An Act to amend the Judiciary Act 1903-1937.

[Reserved for His Majesty's pleasure, 9th September, 1939.]

[Royal Assent proclaimed, 23rd November, 1939.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :--

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Judiciary Act 1939.

(2.) The Judiciary Act 1903-1937\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Judiciary Act 1903-1939.

Original jurisdiction conferred. 2. Section thirty of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by adding at the end of paragraph (a) the word " and "; and
- (b) by omitting paragraph (b).

Repeal of Section 30A.

3. Section thirty  $\mathbf{A}$  of the Principal Act is repealed.
