## LOAN (No. 2).

## No. 45 of 1940.

## An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of a certain Sum of Money, and for other purposes.

## [Assented to 22nd June, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan Act (No. 2) 1940.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may, from time to time, borrow, under the provisions of the *Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act* 1911-1940, or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Twenty million pounds.

4. The amount borrowed may be issued and applied for the expenses of borrowing and for the purposes of appropriations made, or to be made, by law.

5. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any loan raised under the authority of this Act, or of any other Act, the sum of Twenty million pounds for war purposes.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Loan Act 1939, the Loan Act (No. 2) 1939 or the Loan Act 1940, the whole or any portion of the amounts specified in the Schedule to any of those Acts for purposes of the Department of Supply and Development so specified may be issued and applied for the corresponding purposes of the Department of Munitions.
