

HIGH COMMISSIONER.

No. 52 of 1940.

An Act to amend section nine of the *High Commissioner Act 1909-1937*.

[Assented to 22nd August, 1940.]

[Date of commencement, 19th September, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the *High Commissioner Act 1940*. Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *High Commissioner Act 1909-1937**, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *High Commissioner Act 1909-1940*

2. Section nine of the *High Commissioner Act 1909 1937* is amended— High
Commissioner
may appoint
officers.

(a) by omitting sub-section (3.); and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (5.) the words “, subject to sub-section (3.) of this section,”.
