REGULATIONS UNDER THE MEAT EXPORT CONTROL ACT 1935-1938.*

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Meat Export Control Act* 1935-1938.

AMENDMENTS OF THE MEAT EXPORT CONTROL (STAFF) REGULATIONS.†

1. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation Commencement.
on the first day of September, 1937.

2. Regulation 11A of the Meat Export Control (Staff) Regulations Allowance to Executive Officer, London.
is amended by adding at the end of sub-regulation (1.) the following paragraph:—

“; and (d) until the appointment of a London Representative in pursuance of section 14 of the Act, an allowance at the rate of Twenty pounds per month.”

3. The Schedule to the Meat Export Control (Staff) Regulations Schedule.
is amended—

(a) by inserting in Table A, after the words and figures—

“Executive Officer, London | 750 | .. ”

the words and figures—

“Assistant to Executive Officer, London .. | 600 | 750 ”; and

(b) by inserting in Table B, after the words and figures—

“Executive Officer, London | 1 10 0 ”

the words and figures—

“Assistant to Executive Officer, London | 1 10 0 ”.
