Amendment of the National Security (Supplementary) REGULATIONS.

Regulation 28‡ of the National Security (Supplementary) Regula-Daylight tions is amended by omitting sub-regulation (2.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

"(2.) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law of the Commonwealth or of any State or Territory, from the hour of two o'clock in the morning of Sunday, the third day of October, 1943, until the hour of two o'clock in the morning of Sunday, the twenty-sixth day of March, 1944, summer time shall, in respect of each State (other than the State of Western Australia) and in respect of each Territory, be one bour in advance of standard time.".
