AMENDMENTS OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY (GENERAL) REGULATIONS.

- 1. Regulation 60r of the National Security (General) Regulations Determination is amendedcompensation
 - (a) by inserting in sub-regulation (2.) after the word "month" the words "or such further time as the Minister allows";
 - (b) by inserting in sub-regulation (3.) after the word "month" the words "or such further time as the Minister allows".
- 2. Regulation 60g of the National Security (General) Regulations Applications is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "fourteen for review. days" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "one month".
