AMENDMENTS OF THE WAR FINANCIAL (MILITARY PORCES) REQUIATIONS.

- 1.-(1.) Regulation 4 of the War Financial (Military Forces) Deanthors. Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of "child" and inserting in its stead the following definition:-
 - "'child' means any child (including an ex-nuptial child) who is a son, daughter, step-son or step-daughter or a legally adopted son or daughter of a member and who is-
 - (a) under the age of sixteen years; or
 - (b) over the age of sixteen years but under the age of eighteen years and who is receiving education as a full-time student at a school, college or university;".
- (2.) The amendment effected by this regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the eleventh day of July, 1945,
- 2 .- (1.) Regulation 26 of the War Financial (Military Forces) Repeal of restabling 26. Regulations is repealed:
- (2.) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-first day of March, 1945.
- 3. Regulation 33 of the War Financial (Military Forces) Regula-treatment for tions is amended by inserting, after the word "Regulations", the words which wenter or regulation 293 of the Australian Military Regulations".
