### REGULATION UNDER THE IMMIGRATION ACT 1901-1940.\*

#### AMENDMENT OF THE IMMIGRATION REQULATIONS.

Regulation 5 of the Immigration Regulations is amended-

(a) by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the words "subject to payment of the fee for extension prescribed in sub-regulation (4.) of this regulation"; and

(b) by omitting sub-regulation (4.).
