**REGULATIONS UNDER THE IMMIGRATION ACT 1901-1948.\***

## AMENDMENTS OF THE IMMIGRATION REGULATIONS.

1. After regulation 4 of the Immigration Regulations the following regulation is inserted :----

"4A. A declaration by an intending immigrant under sub-section Form of (2.) of section 3 of the Act shall be in accordance with Form A and declaration with result in the section shall be made and subscribed before an officer.". shall be made and subscribed before an officer.".

2. After regulation 44 of the Immigration Regulations the following regulations are added :---

"45. An application for registration as a registered agent shall be Application in accordance with a form approved by the Minister and shall be 14H. forwarded to the Secretary to the Department of Immigration or to the Commonwealth Migration Officer in the capital city of the State

in which the applicant carries on business. "46. An application for registration as a registered agent shall be Fee for application. accompanied by a lodgment fee of One pound. "47. A certificate of registration as a registered agent shall be in Certificate of registration.

"48. An application for an extension of the period of registration Application for of an agent shall be in accordance with a form approved by the <sup>extension</sup>. Minister and shall, at least fourteen days before the expiration of the period of registration specified in the certificate of registration, be forwarded, together with the certificate of registration, to the Secretary to the Department of Immigration or to the Commonwealth Migration Officer in the capital city of the State in which the applicant carries on business as a registered agent.

"49. Where the Minister or an authorized officer cancels the registication of tration of a registered agent he shall notify the person to whom the registration. certificate of registration was issued that his registration has been cancelled.

"50.--(1.) Where the registration of a registered agent is cancelled, Return of he shall, within fourteen days after the date of the notification of the cortificate of cancellation of his registration, forward the certificate of registration upon to the Commonwealth Migration Officer in the capital city of the expiration. State in which he carried on business as a registered agent.

"(2.) Where the period specified in a certificate of registration expires and is not extended, the person to whom the certificate was issued shall, within fourteen days after the date upon which the certificate ceased to be in force, return the certificate to the Commonwealth Migration Officer in the capital city of the State in which he carried on business as a registered agent.".

3. The Schedule to the Immigration Regulations is amended—(a) by inserting, before Form B, the following form:—
