An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of a certain Sum of Money.

[Assented to 29th June, 1951.]

E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan Act 1951.

Short title.

- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement. receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. The Treasurer may, from time to time, borrow, under the Authority to provisions of the Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1946, or \$\frac{borrow}{\text{\text{\text{c}}10,500,000}}\$. under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Ten million five hundred thousand pounds.

4. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for Purposes for the expenses of borrowing and for the purposes of appropriations may be made or to be made by law.

5. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any Issue and loan raised under the authority of this Act, or any other Act, the sum application of £10,500,000. of Ten million five hundred thousand pounds for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
