

## MINISTERS OF STATE.

### No. 17 of 1951.

## An Act to amend the *Ministers of State Act* 1935-1947.

[Assented to 16th July, 1951.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Ministers of State Act* 1951. Short title  
and citation.
- (2.) The *Ministers of State Act* 1935-1947\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Ministers of State Act* 1935-1951.
2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent. Commencement.
3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word "nineteen" and inserting in its stead the word "twenty". Number of  
Ministers.
4. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "Twenty-seven thousand six hundred and fifty pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "Twenty-nine thousand pounds". Salaries of  
Ministers.
