REGULATION UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1951.\*

AMENDMENT OF THE FINANCIAL (MILITARY) REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 20 of the Financial (Military) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“20. Where married quarters are provided by the Commonwealth for a member, a deduction of such amount as the Minister, with the concurrence of the Treasurer, directs shall be made from his daily rate of pay in respect of his occupancy of those quarters.” <sup>Rent of married quarters.</sup>
