REGULATIONS UNDER THE DAIRY PRODUCE EXPORT CONTROL ACT 1924-1947.*

AMENDMENT OF THE DAIRY PRODUCE EXPORT CONTROL (FEES AND EXPENSES) REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 5 of the Dairy Produce Export Control (Fees and Expenses) Regulations is amended—

Travelling expenses.

(a) by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

“(1.) Where a member is necessarily absent overnight from his place of residence in connexion with his attendance at a meeting of the Board or of the Executive Committee of the Board or while he is engaged on such business of the Board as the Board determines, he shall receive—

(a) an allowance at the rate of Three pounds three shillings per day to cover travelling expenses reasonably incurred by him in attending that meeting or in engaging on that business; or

(b) if payment of allowance at the rate specified in the last preceding paragraph is insufficient to cover those travelling expenses—the amount of those travelling expenses.”; and

(b) by omitting the proviso to sub-regulation (2.).

2. Regulation 1 of these Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, 1952. Commencement.
