

COLONIAL LIGHT DUES LEGISLATION
REPEAL.

No. 12 of 1960.

An Act to repeal the Acts relating to Colonial
Light Dues.

[Assented to 13th May, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Colonial Light Dues Legislation Repeal Act 1960.* Short title.

2.—(1.) Subject to the next succeeding sub-section, this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-fifth day of March, One thousand nine hundred and sixty. Commencement.

(2.) Section four of this Act shall come into operation on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty.

3. The following Acts are repealed:—
