An Act to repeal the Acts relating to Colonial Light Dues.

[Assented to 13th May, 1960.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Colonial Light Dues Legisla- short title. tion Repeal Act 1960.
- 2.—(1.) Subject to the next succeeding sub-section, this Act commenceshall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-fifth day of March, One thousand nine hundred and sixty.

- (2.) Section four of this Act shall come into operation on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty.
