AMENDMENTS OF THE ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE REGULATIONS.†

1. Sub-regulation (1.) of regulation 2, and regulation 3, of these Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the fourteenth day of July, 1961. ^{Commence-}

2.—(1.) Regulation 46 of the Royal Military College Regulations is amended by omitting the table in sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following table:—

Class.	Rate of pay per day.
Fourth Class	Eighteen shillings and threepence
Third Class	Nineteen shillings and sixpence
Second Class	One pound one shilling and ninepence
First Class	One pound nine shillings and fourpence

(2.) Regulation 46 of the Royal Military College Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the words "One shilling and sixpence" and inserting in their stead the words "Three shillings".

3. Regulation 47 of the Royal Military College Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "Nine shillings and sixpence" and inserting in their stead the words "Nine shillings and ninepence". ^{Allowances.}
