AUSTRALIAN UNIVERSITIES COMMISSION

No. 28 of 1962.

An Act to increase to Seven the Maximum Number of Members of the Australian Universities Commission, and for purposes connected therewith.

[Assented to 21st May, 1962.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Australian Universities Short title Commission Act 1962.

- (2.) The Australian Universities Commission Act 1959* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Australian Universities Commission Act 1959-1962.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it Commencereceives the Royal Assent.

- 3. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Establishment from sub-section (2.) the word "four" and inserting in its stead the word "six".
- 4. Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by inserting Meetings. in paragraph (b) of sub-section (5.), after the word "five", the words " or more ".
