(ADDITIONAL CONTRIBUTION).

An Act to approve the payment by Australia of an
Additional Contribution to the International
Development Association.

[Assented to 30th October, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *International Development Association (Additional Contribution) Act 1963*. Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent. Commencement.

3. The approval of the Parliament is hereby given to the payment by Australia to the International Development Association of an additional contribution not exceeding a sum equivalent to Nineteen million eight hundred thousand United States dollars. Approval of payment of additional contribution.

4. Any payment under the last preceding section shall be made out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is appropriated accordingly. Appropriation.

5. Section six of the *International Development Association Act 1960* applies to any payment under section three of this Act as it applies to payments under that Act. Issue of securities.
