MINISTERS OF STATE (No. 2).

No. 71 of 1964.

An Act relating to the Salaries and Allowances of the Ministers of State.

[Assented to 30th October, 1964.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Ministers of State Act Short this (No. 2) 1964.

- (2.) The Ministers of State Act 1952-1959,* as amended by the Ministers of State Act 1964,† is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) Section one of the Ministers of State Act 1964 is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).
- (4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Ministers of State Act 1952-1964.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of commences November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.
- 3. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting salaries of Ministers. the words "Seventy-three thousand three hundred and fifty' and inserting in their stead the words "Ninety-five thousand six hundred and fifty".
- 4. Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Additional the words "Three thousand five hundred" and inserting in their Prime Minister. stead the words "Four thousand".
 - 5. Section seven of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words "One Ministers. thousand five hundred" and inserting in their stead the words "One thousand eight hundred"; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "One thousand two hundred and fifty" and inserting in their stead the words "One thousand five hundred".
