An Act to Increase to Eight the Maximum Number of Members of the Australian Universities Commission.

[Assented to 6 October, 1965]

 B^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation. **1.**—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Australian Universities Commission Act 1965.

(2.) The Australian Universities Commission Act 1959-1962* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Australian Universities Commission Act 1959-1965.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it Commencereceives the Royal Assent.

3. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from Establishment sub-section (2.) the word "six" and inserting in its stead the Commission. word "eight".

4. Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Meetings. sub-section (5.) and inserting in its stead the following subsection :---

"(5.) At a meeting of the Commission, a quorum is constituted---

- (a) if the Commission consists of three or four members by not less than two members;
- (b) if the Commission consists of five or six members—by not less than three members; or
- (c) if the Commission consists of seven or more membersby not less than four members.".
