AMENDMENTS OF THE ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE REGULATIONS†

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the eighteenth day Commencement. of February, 1966.

2. Regulation 46 of the Royal Military College Regulations is amended Pay. by omitting the table in sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following table:-

- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "Ten shillings and threepence" and inserting in their stead the words "One dollar and two cents ".
